**THE CHILDREN'S CENTER ANNOUNCES NEW \$25,000 DONATION
FROM BRIGHAM CITY'S ATK LAUNCH SYSTEMS**

SALT LAKE CITY – Nov. 10, 2008 – ATK Launch Systems, with Utah locations in Brigham City, Clearfield and Salt Lake, has made a \$25,000 donation to The Children's Center, the Salt Lake City-based charitable organization announced.

The ATK donation goes to The Children's Center's ongoing capital campaign. The Children's Center is trying to secure two \$1 million challenge grants on the way to a goal of \$13 million. ATK's gift puts The Children's Center within \$200,000 of reaching that overall goal.

The Children's Center provides comprehensive mental health care to infants, toddlers, preschoolers and their families. The capital campaign has been driven by the need to purchase and renovate The Children's Center's future home at the Oquirrh School in downtown Salt Lake City.

"It is our great pleasure to enjoy an association with The Children's Center that spans 16 years," said Mary Ann Holladay, vice president of human resources for ATK Launch Systems. "Many of our employee volunteers have been touched by their experiences with

both the children and the staff of The Children's Center. We are honored to make this \$25,000 donation.”

The Children's Center will name one of six therapeutic preschool classrooms in its new facility after ATK. The Children's Center's Therapeutic Preschool provides mental health treatment for 144 children daily, five days a week, 52 weeks a year. Children struggling with diagnosable psychiatric disorders including hyperactivity, depression, anxiety, oppositional defiant disorder and autism spectrum disorders usually receive treatment for at least three hours a day over the course of their enrollment, which averages from nine months to one year.

“In our current facility, we have four therapeutic preschool classrooms,” said Dr. Douglas Goldsmith, executive director of The Children's Center. “We have the need to expand to six preschool classrooms at the Oquirrh School, and we're so grateful to our friends of the campaign for their generous donation to help make it possible.”

The Children's Center is a 45-year-old private non-profit dedicated to providing mental health care to young children and their families. Renovation of the Oquirrh School is now underway and The Children's Center's plans to move into the new location in June of 2009. The Children's Center's second location will continue to be in Kearns.
