\$12 Million Has Been Raised To Build Our New Home

It is with great excitement that Scott and I share with all of you our progress on the Campaign for a New Children's Center: Little kids with big problems need your help. We have now received over \$12 million in commitments for the campaign. This figure includes two separate \$1 million challenge grants from the George S. and Dolores Doré Eccles Foundation and The Kresge Foundation. With just under \$1 million still to

raise, we continue to look to our community for help. We have until Fall 2008 to capture these two generous grants.

We are also pleased to tell you that Big D Construction has finished demolition and renovations began in July. The final cost to renovate the Oquirrh School building is \$6.6 million. We will be the first non-profit in Salt Lake to own a historic, Silver LEED Certified building. This will create an environment that will be toxin and allergen free, as well as reduce our O&M costs for the life of our occupancy. The expanded clinical space is more critical than ever since we saw our referrals increase to over 1,500 families last year, and are well on our way to surpassing that number this year.

Thank you for all the generosity and support you have provided to the families served by The Children's Center. Without each of our generous supporters we would not be able to achieve our dream.

Dear Dr. Goldsmith:

Back in 1998, my son and I received counseling from you. He was three years old at the time, and he struggled with aggression and temper outbursts. You gave me some things to work on to help him.

I am happy to report that my son is a healthy teenager. He is still moody, but I believe being of German descent and being an adolescent contributes to that.

I transcribe medical records for a residential treatment facility in Utah County. My heart just breaks as I read about these troubled and lost teenagers, some even as young as ten. I am so grateful for the counseling I received from you at an early age to help my son. I wonder sometimes had we not gotten help at such an early age, if I would be typing reports for him.

Thank you again for the help you offered a struggling, single mother who was also dealing with her own depression. You offered the saving advice I so desperately needed at the time.

Sanctuary

When I was invited to return to working for The Children's Center last April, it was the fulfillment of a career dream that I had carried for ten years. During the 90's, I had spent five years as a group therapist at the East side center. After working with foster children for eight years and the last six years in private practice, I had spent a great deal of my professional career providing mental health services to children and their caregivers. Working in this field had been fulfilling, but demanding. While I liked working as an agency of one, I always kept a special place in my heart for The Children's Center. This is where I had begun so many years ago. When the opportunity to return to The Children's Center arose, I jumped at the chance to return to my roots, clinically and professionally.

When I came back, I was given a new challenge: to direct the day to day operations of one of the special programs at The Children's Center. Some call it Eskuche. Some call the Group Home. Others call it Residential Care. But the concept is the same. It is the establishment of a sanctuary for traumatized children, many of whom have no where else to go.

During my third week back, we admitted a new child. This little slip of a five year old girl had just arrived at The Children's Center Residential Center late in the day. Traumatized by years of parental neglect, inconsistent living arrangements and severe domestic violence, she was once again having to change where she lived. She desperately clung to the hand of the experienced residential staff member as she

was shown her room. She looked up at the staff member holding her hand and sadly asked, "Are the bad men going to break in and kill me?" The staff member quickly bent down to eye level and began reassuring her that she was safe here. She was shown how we keep children safe, the clean bedroom where she would sleep, where the big people would watch over her day and night, and where she would play in the morning. She was then fed some of her favorite foods and repeatedly comforted as she fell asleep in the first clean and quiet bedroom that she had ever known. She slept while the staff member carefully watched over her in the night. And she has thrived in the weeks since her arrival.

With the help of generous community support,

helpful volunteer workers, and the tireless efforts of many committed staff members, the Residential Center continues to meet the needs of this little girl and other children of our community and has done so for twenty six years. This little girl is now preparing to leave to go to a warm and supportive potentially adoptive home. She is bright and happy. She trusts big people again. And she no longer fears for her safety.

The staff members stand ready at a moment's notice to open the front door, take these children in need by the hand, and establish for them a safe and helpful place. Some call it Eskuche. Some call it The Residential Center. I call it Sanctuary. And with help from all of you, we can continue to call it "Ours."
